Vince Giordano and Genevieve Rose — Double Bass

Award Winning Vince Giordano and Genevieve Rose — Two Talented Bass Players will be on tap again this year along with 13 talented trad jazz musicians for the weekend of Oct. 10-12. You've seen them before if you've been to Jeff and Joel's House Parties and we're pleased to have them again.



Vince Giordano, leader of "The Nighthawks", is well known to our jazz fans. We were with him at JJHP when he received word of his Grammy Award for his music in Boardwalk Empire. He is a big-band historian collecting and then playing the original arrangements from the early 1900s. If you closed your eyes you would think you were dancing in the Rainbow Ballroom in the 1920s.

He has been featured in several TV series and movies and his Nighthawks regularly perform in New York and vicinity including the Lincoln Center for Performing Arts and a recent appearance on "Prairie

Home Companion".

He is a very versatile musician playing everything from violin and piano to the tuba and various bass instruments including his "aluminum" bass viol.

Don't miss seeing him on Friday evening with Molly Ryan and Dan Levinson. He'll be performing all weekend as well.



Genevieve Rose is a New England-based freelance acoustic and electric bassist; she performs nationally with a variety of jazz, big band, vocal, dixieland, and Latin ensembles. She currently serves as the director for the Smith College Jazz Ensemble (Northampton, MA), teaches instrumental music teacher at Orchard Hill School (South Windsor, CT), and is a faculty member of the Jazz in July Summer Music Programs at the University of Massachusetts, Amherst.

Genevieve Rose and Vince Giordano both played at our house party #2 in the fall of 2012 and fun was certainly to be had with this bass duo. Here is Genevieve trading 4's with Paul Monat on the Tuba during "My Gal Sal"
