**Hi JJHP Jazz Fans!**

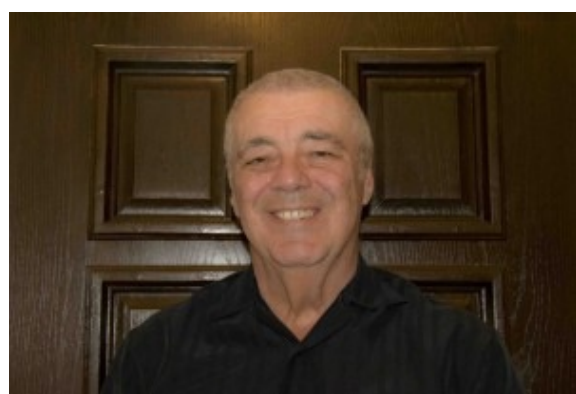

**Bob Ferguson on Trumpet**

Trumpet soloist Bob Ferguson has been performing in Casino Hotel properties and Concert venues throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico, Europe and the Caribbean for over 30 years. Bob Ferguson is a very talented music stylist. He is comfortable performing in any size venue with all styles of Traditional Jazz, Jazz Rock, Rock, Latin, Country, R&B or Big Band music.

Bob has appeared in the Clifford Brown Jazz Festival in Delaware, Music Fest of Bethlehem Pennsylvania, The Chicago Blues Festival, The Cape May Jazz Festival, The Somers Point Jazz Festival, The Philadelphia Folk Festival, JVC Jazz Festival in NYC, The San Juan Jazz Festival, and Chicago Blues Festival. From 2005 to 2009 Bob performed with the Atlantic City Jazz Band and The Saxula Brass Band of San Gregorio Del Sassola as a music ambassador of American Traditional Jazz, performing in over eleven cities throughout Italy. Bob has recorded and performed with Latin sensation Cintron for 15 years, including the inauguration of President George Bush and Bill Clinton in Washington.



**Herb Roselle on Trombone**

Professional jazz trombonist, arranger, business owner, and now retired, pursuing whatever **musical** interests i fancy. He's been playing New Orleans Jazz since 1966 beginning at the Jersey shore. He joined Your Father's Mustache in 1967, which turned out to be an excellent "training ground" for learning a wide variety of songs and also developing facility in different keys.

He played with the Red Garter and the Atlantic City casinos, becoming a band leader in the process. In 2005, he formed the Atlantic City Jazz Band, and took that band on several trips to Italy. That band still performs extensively.



**Herb Gardner on Trombone and Piano**

Soon after moving to New York in 1963, Herb Gardner began touring with Wild Bill Davison, Kenny Davern and Dick Wellstood as well as becoming a regular at the Metropole, Jimmy Ryan's and Eddie Condon's nightclubs. During the '60's and 70's he appeared with virtually all of the classic jazz musicians in the New York City area such as Roy Eldridge, Gene Krupa, Henry "Red" Allen, Bobby Hackett, Jimmy Rushing, Doc Cheatham, Max Kaminsky and even Wingy Manone.

For many years he served as co-leader of Vince Giordano's playing for the inauguration of George Bush, Bill Clinton's victory party and countless other society affairs. In June, 1997 he conducted the "Big Broadcasters" in the opening concert of the New York City JVC Jazz festival.

Herb has written the music and words to many specialty songs heard regularly on New York radio, including "Jazzbeaux's Time of Night" and theme songs for many other radio personalities.

Herb Gardner played with us for our first house party back in October of 2012. Here he is taking a nice solo with Bria Skonberg and Joe Midiri in Joe Avery Blues.
